

The church is now open for in person worship. Here's what to expect if you join us Sunday mornings:

- All doors will be propped open
- Masks will be available if you don't have your own, you can leave them at the church and they will be laundered before next week.
- There will be no coffee fellowship time
- You will be asked to immediately take your seat
- Social distancing will be maintained
- If you choose to not wear a mask, you will be seated in the fellowship hall
- There will be no touching of common items: offering plate, hymnals, Bibles, etc
- Ushers will dismiss family groups following the service to avoid bottlenecks at the door
